This house tells a 300-year-old story with its distinctive Istrian stone walls, inside which there is a beautifully decorated ambiance. The house is a two-story building with a square footage of 300 m2 and consists of a total of 5 bedrooms, each with its bathroom, one separate toilet, spacious living room, and dining room, fully equipped kitchen, laundry room, social room with exercise equipment, pool table, and table football. and a relaxation room with a jacuzzi and sauna. The house is heated with gas central heating, and air conditioning is installed in each bedroom. There is also a wood-burning fireplace in the living room, which further enhances the atmosphere and atmosphere in the room.

On the well-maintained and fully fenced yard of 1800 m2, in addition to the arranged sunbathing area, there is a heated swimming pool with automatic water disinfection (salt water) of 55 m2, a children's playground, parking, and a covered terrace with a dining table and a stone grill. Planted plants a beautiful grassy area and a view of the pool guarantee the enjoyment of summer evenings, and the facilities that this villa offers allow for maximum relaxation and enjoyment. The house is located in a very accessible and well-connected location, and the fenced yard offers peace, quiet, and privacy.
